## Colonials, close to downtown Merrick

hree new Colonials, located near the center of downtown Merrick at 2057, 2061 and 2065 Sherman Ave., are for sale.

Construction on the two-story brick and vinyl homes began in June, with the last to be completed in April, says builder Noel Cooperstein, president of Custom Village Homes Corp. in East Meadow.

The homes range from 3,800 to 4,000 square feet, with prices from \$899,000 to \$965,000, Cooperstein says. Each house is situated on a 55-by-125-foot lot. Two have four bedrooms and 21/2 bathrooms, and one has five bedrooms and 31/2 bathrooms.

The kitchens, which are all the same, have granite countertops, maple cabinets and GE stainless-steel appliances.

The master bathrooms have double granite vanities, an oversize corner whirlpool tub and an oversize shower.

The homes also have fireplaces in the family rooms, two-car garages, unfinished

basements with 8-foot ceilings, 24 from Jones Beach and Roosevelt high-hat ceiling lights, walk-in closets Field. All houses are in the Merrick in all bedrooms, some cathedral school district. ceilings, oak flooring, two-zone gas
heat, central air-conditioning and

The four-bedroom houses also have front porches. "These are trade-up homes that will appeal to families who

want an easy commute to Manhattan and also want the convenience of various nearby parkways," Cooperstein says.

The houses are less than five minutes by car from shopping and restaurants in Merrick,
